History

The J Associates began in 1985 as a small group of caring women who saw a need for volunteer help at the Jewish Community Center gift shop. The focus of the newly formed women's auxiliary group was to have a wonderful time through social activities. while inspiring Jewish values and raising money for the departments and programs of the J. This diverse group of women created a charter and continued to grow – forming lifelong friendships, offering leadership training and opportunities and fundraising in support of the J. To date, the more than 500 members of the J Associates have raised in excess of one million dollars in support of J programs, scholarships and equipment. Most important, however, is the camaraderie and friendships that are developed through working together.



Social Programs

The J Associates takes pride in their creativity and imagination in producing informative, entertaining and meaningful events. Committees are the driving force behind the wonderful programming and often result in instant friendships. Highlighting the year was Lip Sync Live, the largest fundraising event. The Annual Luncheon and Installation of Officers celebrates J Associates' leaders, honors local volunteers as Mitzvah Stars and celebrates the accomplishments of the fundraising year.

Other great events dotting the calendar included BBB (Brunch, Boutique and Bunches of Games), Party with a Purpose – a celebration of the J Associates 30th anniversary, Food for Thought, Games Day, the JABC-J Associates Book Club and serving Shabbat dinner to the residents at Covenant Place once a month. Events vary in scope from several hundred attendees from the community to member-based meetings and gatherings intended for J Associates members.



Special Events

The J Associates hosts a variety of entertaining and successful events throughout the year to raise funds for the J. Since the J Associates inception, more than 1.4 million dollars has been raised in support of J programs and scholarships. Two of our most highly anticipated community events include Lip Sync Live and Dancing in the Loop. Lip Sync Live features St. Louis volunteer stars lip syncing to a variety of musical genres from Dancing Queen to Michael Jackson. Dancing in the Loop features J celebrities paired with dancing professionals waltzing and tangoing across the stage. A fun summertime event is BBB which combines good shopping, delicious food, camaraderie and games into one wonderful afternoon that raises funds.



Fundraising

Touching all areas of the J, from infants to the elderly, J Associates fundraising has contributed to programs such as Kitchen J's Home Delivered Meals and Theatre Unlimited (stage performance for adults with special needs), while also helping to make scholarships available for children for J Day Camps, the Early Childhood Center and Youth Theatre. Projects receiving funds include life-enhancing programming, youth and adult fitness equipment and fine arts projects – from Early Childhood music to the J's renowned New Jewish Theatre. Funding has assisted in the purchase of blood pressure machines, defibrillators, fishing gear and infant buggies. Recently, the J Associates donated funds for a cabin at Camp Sabra, the J's resident camp at the Lake of the Ozarks.
