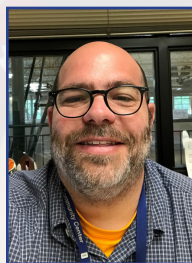

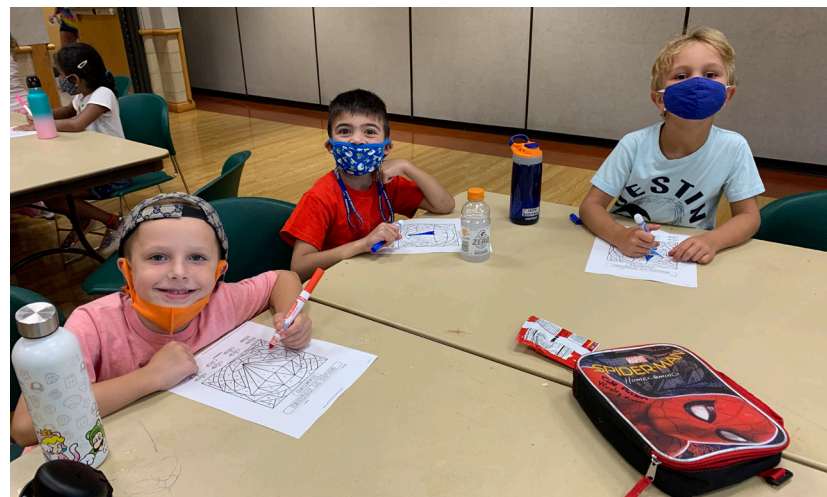
Introducing Chloe, SFC Specialist
