LUNCH

Campers are to bring lunch in a reusable soft lunch sack (or a brown paper bag) Monday through Friday. Out of concern for the health of other campers, please refrain from bringing items containing nuts. If your child has food allergies, please notify the camp director. Due to the different food needs of all our campers and staff, individual lunches may not be shared. Since all lunches are refrigerated, your choice of items to send is really unlimited; the most important elements are nutrition. variety and creativity.

If your camper is attending both morning and afternoon sessions of the Technology Camps, there will be a supervised lunch break between 11:45am – 12:15pm.

We provide campers with a Kosher and nut-free snack daily. If your camper has any other dietary needs, please feel free to send a snack from home.
