



JCC Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

The Jewish Community Center operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by the Jewish Community Center, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with the Jewish Community Center:

1. You may obtain a complaint form by going to the JCC website at jccstl.com and going to the Adult Day Center or Inclusion Department section. In these sections, there is a Title VI complaint form that can be printed out. Or you may obtain one by contacting Sally Lang- Director, Community Relations at (314) 442-3241.
2. In addition to the complaint process at the Jewish Community Center, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region 7, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106, phone (816) 329-3920.
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
