Soccer Kick, Around the World

1. Contestants must use the official ball furnished by the St. Louis Senior Olympics.
2. The goal is 10 feet in height.
3. A second net will be provided as a designated practice area. There are no official practice kicks.
4. Men and women $50-69$ kick from 36 feet (worth 1 point each) and 45 feet (worth 2 points each). The center kick is from 54 feet (worth 2 points each).
5. Men and women $70+$ kick from 27 feet (worth 1 point each) and 36 feet (worth 2 points each). The center kick is from 45 feet.
6. All kicks start on the right outside, shortest distance spot and move through the shorter distances. Then the longer distances, starting with the left outside and moving around. The last kick is from the center spot.
7. Each kicker gets two kicks from each spot. Each kick counts for points.
8. In case of a tie, the player with the most consecutive kicks is declared the winner. If a tie remains, the player achieving the consecutive series earlier in the 18 kicks is the winner. Only in the case of two or more players scoring all 28 points will there be a tie.
